To whom it may concern,

Hospital Damas is a tertiary level hospital with over 150 years of experience and in that time, we have been distinguished by our excellent and high-quality medical services and our prestigious Medical Faculty, which provides services to Puerto Rico's southern area.

With the objective of improving our hospital, we carried out, in conjunction with London Consulting Group, the "Projecto Cemi" improvement project between March and December 2018. The project focused on optimizing the processes in the Medical Utilization, Emergency Room, Operating Room, Surgicenter and the Purchasing and Warehousing departments. During this period, we achieved the following results:

Emergency Room:

- 49% reduction in elopements.
- Implementing a Fast track model (category IV and V), which reduced the patient's waiting times by 56%.

Medical Utilization:

- 23% reduction in the amount of denied days by the Per Diem medical insurance contract.
- 74% reduction in the amount of denied days by the DRG medical insurance contract.
- 22% reduction in exceeded length of stay, using the national standard (ALOS).

Operating Room and Surgicenter:

- Optimizing the Operating Room's personnel's productivity by 29%.
- 82% increase in the Operating Room's real utilization rate (real hours vs programmed hours).

Purchasing and Warehousing:

- 62% improvement in the on-time and in-full (OTIF) deliveries from the warehouse to internal departments.
- Negotiations with suppliers reduced the total amount of money spent on Medical or Surgical goods by (pending).

London Consulting Group has met the expectations established at the beginning of the project, surpassing our expectations, and obtaining a financial return on investment (ROI) of **2.6**: **1** by the end of the project, with a forecasted annualized return of **7.9**: **1**.



 skills which allowed them to achieve their objectives.

The implementation of the program enabled the participants to adopt new tools and concepts which improved their department's operations. The program also developed and strengthened their leadership skills which improved their management of interpersonal relationships.
